The Co-op Family Center is an independent, nonprofit co-operative located in UO Spencer View Family Housing. Student families receive priority and a tuition discount. The center serves children eight weeks to ten years.

### **PERSONAL REFRIGERATOR LENDING PROGRAM**

## FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR CHILD CARE

### **ASUO WOMEN'S CENTER CHILD CARE SCHOLARSHIP**

Students, faculty, and staff who attend a campus event may be reimbursed for child care costs incurred during the event. Applications should be submitted at least 3 weekdays (72 hours) before the event. For more information, call the ASUO Women's Center at (541) 346-4095.

### **EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT**

Working students and UO faculty and staff who have at least one child living with them may be eligible for a tax credit that is based on a percentage of earned income. For more information, call the Payroll Office at (541) 346-1126.

## **OR DEPT OF HUMAN SERVICES CHILD CARE SUBSIDY**
