## FREE SPEECH AND PROTEST

2 Section 1. All students are guaranteed the protections of freedom of speech, as derived from
3 the First Amendment of the Constitution of the United States of America and Section 8 of the
4 Article I of the Constitution of the State of Oregon.

- 6 Section 2. The University shall make every effort to respond to any act of protest, non-violent
- 7 action, or civil disobedience that takes place on university property without involving law
- 8 enforcement. Law enforcement shall only become involved if there is a clear and present threat
- 9 of danger and with advanced notice to all parties involved. In no situation shall tear gas, rubber
- 10 bullets, or blunt force be used on campus.
