4 student workers for each physical space representing a cultural identity. Professional staff in

5 managerial positions within cultural spaces shall be required to complete a cultural competency

6 training once every fall term.

- 8 Section 2. Camas Harvesting. The University shall properly maintain all camas that are
- 9 located on campus. During the months of April through early June, all camas are to be
- 10 uprooted; it shall be given to the Indigenous community on campus (Native American
- 11 Indigenous Studies Arc, Native American Student Union, or The Many Nations Longhouse).

- 13 Section 3. Latinx Cultural Center. The University shall maintain a Latinx Cultural Center
- 14 located centrally on campus. The Latinx Cultural Center requires a facility with at least one (1)
- 15 designated full-time professional staff member and two (2) student worker positions.
